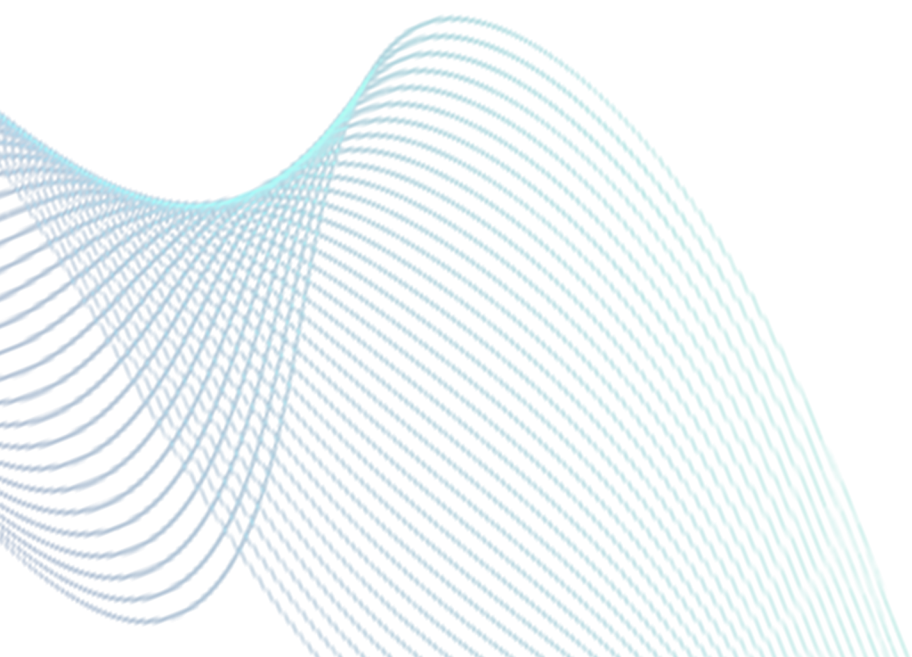

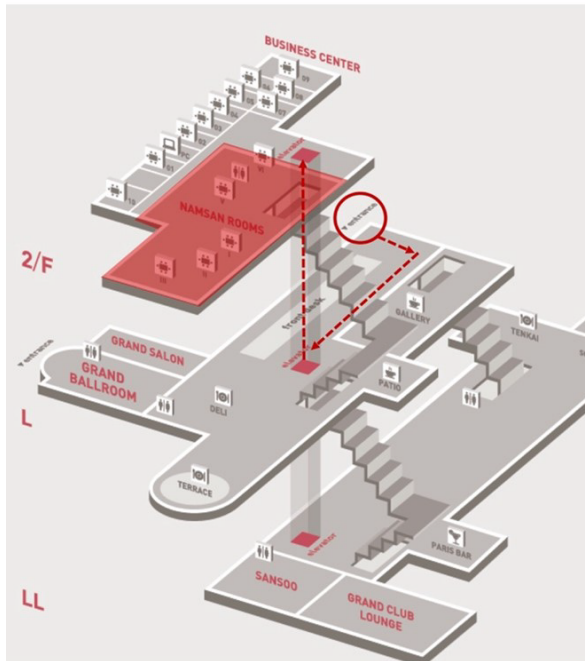

Floor Plan

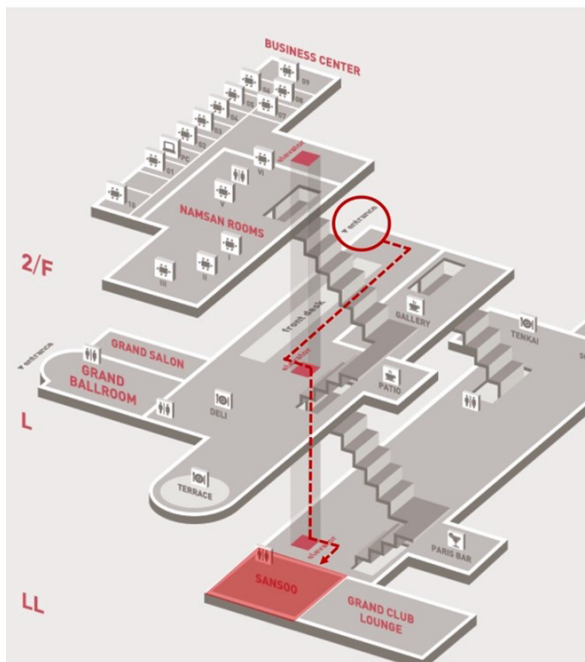

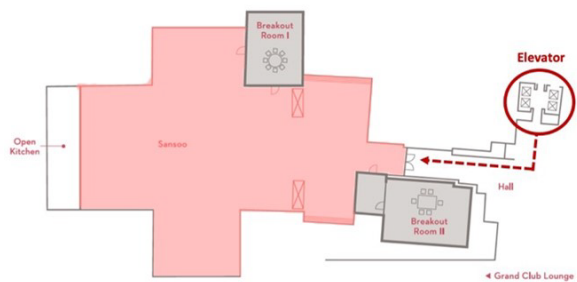
2nd Floor
